

Stand Pisa for 1 chime

Material: beech wood, galvanized steel hook

The wood is treated with natural oil. The stand is designed for interior use. Using the stand outdoors may change its mechanical and visual properties.

The stand is primarily designed for hanging Koshi or Shanti chimes.

The load capacity of the stand is max. 200 g

Instructions for assembling the Pisa stand for 1 chime

The stand consists of 2 separate parts - a base with a hole and a stick with a hook. (fig.1)

1. Place the base on a solid, flat surface with the holes facing upwards.
2. Grasp the stick and turn it hook side up so that the end of the stick without the hook faces the opening of the base.
3. Tilt the stick at an angle - the angle of the stick must follow the hole in the base (Fig.2).
4. Never push the stick perpendicularly into the base, this will damage the hole and the stick. The hole in the base is drilled at an angle that defines the tilt of the stick.
5. Then push the stick firmly into the hole. The stick must be pushed deep into the hole to hold it firmly. If the stick cannot be pushed into the hole, you can rotate the stick around its axis and this twisting motion makes it easier to push into the hole.
